



MLWS Guidelines for Professional Co-Supervisors of Major Graduating Projects (LWS 548)

1. Once the major project proposal has been approved by the Academic Coordinator, MLWS, the professional co-supervisor will communicate (as appropriate and convenient) with the student to discuss and approve the major project.
2. The Supervisory Committee (consisting of the UBC co-supervisor, Professional co-supervisor, and MLWS representative) will review and discuss the student's major project proposal in a meeting at a convenient place and time.
3. The Supervisory Committee will review and evaluate the student's major project (written and oral presentation) in the final month of the program (early August).
4. The Professional co-supervisor agrees to provide appropriate aid and professional guidance to the student.
5. All previously identified and approved financial support will be provided by MLWS, unless otherwise agreed.

(All co-supervisors should maintain a list of topics of their interest, appropriate for MLWS students)

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
